**Notice is hereby given that the Lindstrom City Council will hold the annual Board of Appeal & Equalization Hearing on Monday, April 14, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., at the Lindstrom City Hall.**

The purpose of the meeting is to determine whether taxable property in the City has been properly valued and classified by the assessor, and to determine whether corrections need to be made. All persons considering themselves aggrieved by said assessment are hereby notified to **send a written statement no later than April 10, 2020** explaining why the assessment should be corrected or modified. Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1, members of the public will **not** be permitted to enter the regular meeting location for the Lindstrom City Council for the annual Board of Appeal & Equalization Hearing. The Mayor and City Administrator have determined that permitting the public to enter the regular meeting location (Lindstrom City Hall) is not prudent because of the health pandemic involving COVID-19. Stat. § 13D.021, subd. 1.
