Cemetery Guidelines

- All flowers & plants must be contained in plant holders, elevated at least 18" from the ground. No other items are allowed.
- Wreaths are permitted from November through April, and must be mounted on plant stands.
- Flowers may be placed on gravesites one week prior to Memorial Day and must be removed by June 15th.
- The first 5 working days in May are designated for cemetery cleanup.
- Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Pets are not allowed on cemetery grounds.
- Cemetery grounds are closed from 10:00pm to sunrise.

Fairview Columbarium

The Fairview Cemetery Columbarium is a stately granite monument dedicated to the safekeeping of cremated remains. Located at the south end of the cemetery, 40 niches face east and 40 niches face west.

Each niche measures 11.5" tall and wide at the opening, narrows to 10.5" wide at the back, and is 11.5" deep. Up to two cremains are allowed in each niche. A bronze marker plaque is included with the niche purchase. (See inside of pamphlet for pricing.)

About Fairview Cemetery

The Fairview Cemetery is situated on approximately ten acres at the east end of Lindström, on the south side of Highway 8. The city maintains the cemetery property year round (excluding monuments). Plots and Columbarium niches are available to residents and non-residents.

Original Section and First Addition

The Original Section is on the north end of the cemetery, and dates back to the late 1800's. South Center Lake is along the east end. The First Addition was later added, and borders the southern edge of the Original Section. Plots in these sections allow for both traditional and cremation burials. (For pricing and monument information, see the following sections of this pamphlet.)



Third Addition

The Third Addition (formerly known as the Second Addition) is the newest section of the cemetery. It is located on both the east and west sides of the central cemetery road, south of the First Addition. Plots in this section allow for both traditional and cremation burials.

4.5' wide x 5' long; up to two cremains.

Monuments and Markers <u>Guidelines</u>

- Monuments and markers must be constructed of granite, marble, or bronze material. Placement must be approved by the City.
- In the Original Section, the base area of monuments shall not exceed 4'5" in width by 20" in length. Markers may protrude above the ground in this section only.
- In the First Addition and Third Addition, the base area of monuments shall not exceed 4'5" in width by 20" in length. Only flat headstone and footstone markers are allowed in the First and Third Additions.
- Monuments are considered private property of the relatives; the relatives are responsible for their care and maintenance.
