

What is *alleman*s rätt?

*Alleman*s rätt, translated *all men's right*, is a Swedish word that expresses a concept of land ownership entitling the general public to access wilderness for recreation and exercise.



What is *Alleman*s rätt Wilderness Park?

*Alleman*s rätt Wilderness Park is a nature preserve in Lindstrom, Minnesota dedicated to celebrating its local Swedish heritage and the right to roam. It consists of over 90 acres of wilderness including a private lake, wetlands bounded by high glacial eskers, and oak, maple and basswood trees over 150 years old. In fact, most of the land is as it was when the first immigrants came to Lindstrom.



Who are the Friends of *Alleman*s rätt?

Friends of *Alleman*s rätt is a group of people who have embraced the responsibility to look after the park. We are dedicated to preserving and protecting the valuable wilderness experience, making it available and accessible to all people as well as conserving it for future generations. We hope that by promoting the use of *Alleman*s rätt Park, we can bring the community together through the wilderness experience.


How do we protect the wilderness?
