Do Not Flush "Flushable" Wipes

Please do NOT flush disposable wipes into the Sanitary Sewer System. Many of the wipes state on the package that they are flushable, but they do not break down like toilet paper in our system.

The use of these wipes has caused a dramatic increase in blockages and plugged lift station pumps in recent years.

Increased maintenance costs ultimately effects city water/sewer utility rates.

City Projects & Development Updates

Meredees/Peninsula- The Developer stated that production is now in queue at the factory.

Morning Sun Phase 3 & 4- Phase 3 has only a few lots remaining. The developer will extend the road this spring, and then start on Phase 4, which will consist of 22 units. Phase 4 is the final phase of this development.

Golf Estates- Building permits have been approved, and the first home is going up.

Albrecht Land- Next is annexation and final plat. Looking for a developer.

Olinda Apartments-Occupancy has begun, and is filling up. Some of the exterior details will not be completed until spring.

Twin Oaks/Lyman Court Phase Two- This development, off of County Road 19, is a replat of 11 lots with 4 additional lots, for a total of 15 new townhome lots. The 11 lots to the south are available now, after the developer was able to solve the gas main issue.

Glader Blvd. Linn Lake Preserve/Olinda Trail- The developer is revising the plan based on DNR input. The project has moved to 2023.

Veteran's Housing (Tingsryd Gardens)- A preliminary plat for 8 townhomes, which will surround the Community Garden that is across from the new Fire Hall location, was submitted to the City for consideration.

Allemansratt Bridge- Progress continues. The remainder of the work will be completed in spring.

Olinda Trail Trail- Bid opening is in early March. Council consideration of the bids will be at the March City Council meeting.

Lindstrom Fire Hall- The trusses and roof will arrive during first quarter of 2022. Completion is hopefully in December 2022.

Lindstrom Police Hall- The project was included on the Governor's Bonding Bill request. Meetings continue with legislators.

Newlander/Elm Street- A total reconstruct for the section of road is anticipated this summer. Plans should be complete for bidding in March. Bids will then be presented to City Council for consideration.

Peninsula Ave./Irene Court- A reclaim is scheduled for this year- no dates yet. This will be similar to last year's Cedar Ridge project.

Public Works Geographical Information System (GIS)

Our <u>Public Works Department</u> is responsible for thousands of services within Lindström.

In order to keep track of all of this infrastructure, Public Works has to collect, store, and process a massive amount of information. Modern day technology makes this abundantly easier, and in some cases, even possible.

The city's new Geographical Information System (GIS) is used to accomplish this complicated task. Photos and GPS locations of City

signs, manhole covers, street surfaces, curb stops, park trails, etc., as well as video of the inside of our sewer systems, is all documented in GIS.

Some of this information is used to determine city project priority, now and in the future.

GIS also makes it easier to locate issues that may otherwise be difficult to see or precisely locate to address a repair. It also assists our staff in quickly locating important specific infrastructure in the event of an emergency or a maintenance task.

This invaluable tool saves the city time and money by having accurate data quickly at hand.

Keep Your Fire Hydrant Cleared

If you have a fire hydrant in your yard, please keep a 3-foot path cleared of snow around the hydrant, clear the hydrant of ice and snow, and keep a path shoveled from the hydrant to the street. Firefighters need to be able to **locate AND access** the fire hydrant quickly in case there is an emergency. Do your part and reveal the red. *Thank you!*



Winter Reminders

Winter Parking

• From November 1st to April 15th there is **NO PARKING** allowed on city streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am or during snow events. This allows our crew to be able to plow in front of your house without having to plow around your vehicles.

Snowmobiles

- Snowmobiles are not allowed to travel on sidewalks, in city parks, or on private property without permission.
- A snowmobile may operate upon the most right -hand lane of a municipal street or alley & may, in passing or making a left turn, operate on other lanes which are used for vehicle traffic in the same direction for purposes of going to or returning from a non-highway area of permissible operation by the most direct route.
- Snowmobiles shall only be allowed to travel on City Streets during the winter season, beginning November 1st through March 31st of each year.



Snow Plow

- Consider replacing your mailbox with a swing style post. This helps prevent it being broken by the weight of the snow.
- If your lot is curved, please place reflective markers near the curb to help guide the snowplows.
- DO NOT plow or shovel snow across streets or into a Right of Way. It is illegal.
- Any personal property located within the Right of Way, including garbage cans, are subject to plowing damage. Garbage cans need to be placed in the driveway, not in the street.

Winter Shoveling

- Snow and ice must be removed from sidewalks within 24 hours of a snowfall.
- Property owners are responsible for the sidewalks that are adjacent to their property.
- Help your neighbors out, especially if you know they are gone or are elderly. Consider clearing their sidewalks & driveways. Thanks for being a good neighbor!
