Allemansrätt Park Improvements

Over the winter, a new boardwalk and bridge were installed in Lindström's Allemansrätt Swedish Heritage and Wilderness Park.



The boardwalk connects the trail loop between Bull Lake and the North Center Channel on the west end of the park. Wetlands surround the boardwalk, which was impassible prior to this improvement.

The bridge was a much larger scale construction project, and is just to the northeast of the boardwalk. This was a much larger scale construction project, and the remainder of the trail work on both ends of the bridge will be finished after the ground firms up this spring.

"Allemansrätt" translates to "every man's right" in Swedish, and is the Swedish philosophy of the right to public access- which includes an implicit responsibility to protect and conserve.

In the spirit of Allemansrätt, we welcome you to walk, ski, snowshoe, run, canoe/kayak or camp (in designated spots). Allemansrätt Park is approximately 125 acres and has several miles of trails, over 10,000 feet of shoreline on three lakes and showcases unique ecological features. Restrooms and benches are available. It is a "carry-in, carry-out" park.

City Projects & Development Updates

Albrecht Land- Expecting a final plat and development agreement soon.

Allemansratt Bridge- The boardwalk and bridge are complete. The final elements will be completed when the ground firms up. For more information on this park, click **HERE**. For an up-to-date map of the park, click **HERE**.

Glader Blvd. Linn Lake Preserve/Olinda Trail- The developer has stopped this project.

Golf Estates- Building permits have been approved, and three homes are under construction.

Lindstrom Fire Hall- The roof is installed, and the floor will be poured soon. Completion is anticipated for December 2022.

Lindstrom Police Hall- The project was included on the Governor's Bonding Bill request. Meetings continue with legislators.

Meredees/Peninsula- The developer stated that production is now in queue at the factory.

Morning Sun Phase 3 & 4- Phase 3 has only a few lots remaining. The developer will extend the road this spring, and then start on Phase 4, which will consist of 22 units. Phase 4 is the final phase of this development.

Newlander/Elm Street- A total reconstruct for this section of road has been approved for this summer.

Olinda Apartments- Occupancy has begun, and is filling up. Some of the exterior details will not be completed until spring.

Olinda Trail Multi-Use Trail (CSAH 25)- Construction has begun. To learn more about the project, potential traffic impacts, and potential temporary water shut offs, click <u>HERE</u>.

Twin Oaks/Lyman Court Phase Two- Awaiting construction in spring.

Veteran's Housing (Tingsryd Gardens)- The preliminary plat has been approved and construction is anticipated to begin in spring.

It's almost summer! Fishing Opener is May 14th

For many Minnesotans, not just serious anglers, fishing opener is considered the unofficial start of summer.

Fishing opener typically falls on Mother's Day weekend, but not in 2022. Minnesota state statute requires the opener to occur precisely two weeks before the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend, so this year opener is on May 14th, and Mother's Day is on May 8th.

This year, Moms will get a special treat! Mothers who are residents of Minnesota can fish without a license during "Take a Mom Fishing

Weekend" (May 7th & 8th, 2022). Click <u>HERE</u> for details on the Minnesota DNR website.

Although many think of the season opener as walleye opener, it also includes a number of species, such as northern pike and trout, and even bass (check fishing regulations for details).

Make sure your fishing license is up to date. They are effective from March 1 to the last day of February of the following year. You can apply for your fishing license from an approved vendor, such as **Holiday Gas Station**

in Lindström, <u>Frankie's Bait & Marine</u> in Chisago City, or the <u>Chisago City License Bureau</u>.

Spring Notices & Reminders

Weed Elimination & Grass Cutting

Weeds and grasses are not allowed to exceed a height of <u>8 inches</u>. Any expenses incurred by the City when performing enforcement and/or cutting will be imposed on the Property Owner.

Noxious weeds and rank vegetation (click for definition) are considered a nuisance according to <u>City Code</u>. Property Owners shall prevent the growth of noxious weeds and remove all noxious weeds on land outside of the traveled portion of any Street or Alley within City Limits. If said weeds are not destroyed by the Property Owner, the City may remove them at the Property Owner's expense.

The term "weeds" does **NOT** include shrubs, trees, cultivated plants or crops. <u>Prairies</u>, as well as <u>butterfly & pollinator</u> <u>gardens</u> are considered cultivated plants if the vegetation is **not listed** in the definition of "<u>noxious weeds and rank vegetation</u>", **AND** are planted in a <u>cultivated manner</u>.

Street Sweeping

- Spring street sweeping generally occurs in May, although if weather permits it
 could start in late April. Sign up for <u>email notifications</u> or follow us on
 <u>Facebook</u> for specific dates.
- The street sweeper moves very slow, so please keep a safe distance.



Fire Hydrant Flushing

- Spring hydrant flushing begins in May. You may experience low water pressure, which should resume to normal pressure shortly after the process is finished.
- "Spitting" or slight water discoloration can occur. If you experience this, let your water run for a short period of time to clear the pipes within your home.

Right-of-Way Planting

The City of Lindström prohibits planting of trees or other vegetation in the boulevard (road right-of-way). Trees and other vegetation may be planted and maintained in drainage and utility easements without a permit from the city at the risk of the property owner and provided that the trees or vegetation do not interfere with access to or use of the easement. (Ordinance 90.23)



Storm Drain Care


- Residents are urged not to blow leaves, grass, dirt, or other debris into the streets. This material can
 wash into the catch-basins and storm drains, causing them to become clogged and not function
 properly.
- This debris can also end up in our lakes, which results in excessive algae growth. To learn more

Lakes Area Compost Site

Weather permitting, the Lakes Area Compost Site is open from mid-April through the Saturday before Thanksgiving. Operating hours are Wednesdays 2pm - 7pm (or dusk), Saturdays 9am - 4pm, and Sundays 1pm - 4pm. The site may temporarily close during inclement weather.

- Allowed: Grass clippings, leaves, and brush up to 3" in diameter
- NOT Allowed: Dimensional lumber, tires, appliances or household trash
- If available, wood chips, compost and black dirt are available for non-commercial use (for free!)
- No commercial businesses are allowed to haul to or from the site.
