It's Almost Summer! Fishing Opener is May 11th

For many Minnesotans, not just serious anglers, fishing opener is considered the unofficial start of summer.

Minnesota state statute requires the opener to occur precisely two weeks before the Saturday of Memorial Day weekend. This year, fishing opener is on Saturday, May 11th. This is also the day before Mother's Day.

You can catch some fish such as crappie, catfish, sunfish, perch and bullhead at any time. Fish such as walleye, northern pike and bass commonly



called gamefish – can only be caught during certain times of the year. Those time periods can vary depending on where you are fishing. Use the **DNR Lake Finder** to find specific regulations for a particular lake, river or stream.

Getting A MN Fishing License

Is your fishing license up to date? Annual licenses are effective from March 1 to the last day of February of the following year.

There is an added cost to fish for trout, salmon, or sturgeon.

Swedish novelist Vilhelm Moberg visited the Chisago Lakes area in 1948 and subsequently wrote his acclaimed series (The Emigrants, Unto a Good Land, The Settlers, and Last Letter Home).

Moberg's fictional characters Karl Oskar and Kristina Nilsson were based on his research of real life Swedish settlers in the Chisago Lakes area. The Karl Oskar House was Karl Oskar and Kristina Nilsson's third home in the novel series. The name of the house, Nya Duvemåla, is a reference to Kristina's fictional Swedish home.



Mayor Chartrand is the first female Mayor in the history of Lindström. Her first term as Mayor began on March 3, 2023. She served as a City Council Member immediately prior to her appointment to Mayor. She previously served as a Lindström Park Commission Member as well as a Lindström Planning Commission Member.

Linda Merkel, Council Member (2021-2024)



Member Merkel began her first 4-year term as a City Council Member in 2021.

Brian Norelius, Council Member (2023-2026)



Member Norelius began his first 4-year term as a City Council Member in January of 2023.

Greg Krueger, Council Member (2023-2024)

Spring Notices & Reminders



Winter Parking Restrictions End April 15th

- From November 1st to April 15th there is **NO PARKING** allowed on city streets between the hours of 2:00 am and 6:00 am or during snow events. This allows our crew to be able to plow in front of your house without having to plow around your vehicles.
- During a snow event, please avoid parking on city streets until the plows have cleared the road.
- If you live in downtown and use the city-owned Park Street Parking Lot for parking, you will need to obtain a winter parking pass. Please contact the <u>Lakes Area Police Department</u> for more information using their non-emergency number 651-257-0622 or stop in at <u>City Hall</u>.

Street Sweeping

- Spring street sweeping generally occurs in May, although if weather permits it could start in late April. Sign up for <u>email notifications</u> or follow us on <u>Facebook</u> for specific dates.
- The street sweeper moves very slow, so please keep a safe distance.



Fire Hydrant Flushing

- Spring hydrant flushing begins in May. You may experience low water pressure, which should resume to normal pressure shortly after the process is finished.
- "Spitting" or slight water discoloration can occur. If you experience this, let your water run for a short period of time to clear the pipes within your home.

Right-of-Way Planting

The City of Lindström prohibits planting of trees or other vegetation in the boulevard (road right-of-way). Trees and other vegetation may be planted and maintained in drainage and utility easements without a permit from the city at the risk of the property owner and provided that the trees or vegetation do not interfere with access to or use of the easement. (Ordinance 90.23)



Storm Drain Care

- Residents are urged not to blow leaves, grass, dirt, or other debris into the streets. This material can
 wash into the catch-basins and storm drains, causing them to become clogged and not function
 properly.
- This debris can also end up in our lakes, which results in excessive algae growth. To learn more


Lakes Area Compost Site Open For Season

Weather permitting, the Lakes Area Compost Site is open from mid-April through the Saturday before Thanksgiving. Operating hours are Wednesdays 2pm - 7pm (or dusk), Saturdays 9am - 4pm, and Sundays 1pm - 4pm. The site may temporarily close during inclement weather.

- Allowed: Grass clippings, leaves, and brush up to 3" in diameter
- NOT Allowed: Dimensional lumber, tires, appliances or household trash
- If available, wood chips, compost and black dirt are available for non-commercial use (for free!)
- No commercial businesses are allowed to haul to or from the site.
