- Asparagus bed weeding, adding compost/manure & watering
- Raspberry bed, weed, water, spray neem oil
- Compost pile maintenance (turning, watering, weeding)
- Walking path maintenance (haul wood chips, weed common walkways)
- Other chores (application of mole/vole repellent, fertilize trees, weed manure pile... etc.)

I have read the Community Garden Rules and understand that failure to meet the guidelines will result in loss of gardening privileges.

Release of all Claims

- (1) I am duly aware of the risks and hazards that may arise through participation in the Community Garden, and assume any expenses and liabilities I incur in the event of an accident, illness, or other incapacity. If I have had any questions about the Community Garden, its nature, risks or hazards, I have contacted the garden coordinator and discussed those questions with him or her to my satisfaction.
- (2) In consideration of being granted the opportunity to participate in the Community Garden, I, for myself, my executors, administrators, agents and assigns do hereby release and forever discharge the Garden Committee, Garden Coordinator, volunteers, other gardeners, and the cooperating landowner from all claims of damages, demands, and any actions whatsoever, including those based on negligence, in any manner arising out of my participation in this activity. I understand that this Release means that, among other things, I am giving up my right to sue for any such losses, damages, injury or costs that I may incur.

I have read this entire Release, fully understand it, and I agree to be legally bound by it.

2024 Rules for the Lindström Community Garden

Before you may begin gardening, registration must be completed and fees must be paid to the City of Lindström, 13292 Sylvan Ave, Lindström, MN 55045. Questions? Please call Sue Kirchner at 651-271-0513

1. Gardening is allowed between the hours of 6:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. (No power tool use until after 8 a.m.)
2. Each gardener is responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of their garden plot. Weeding, harvesting and any other garden related maintenance are the responsibility of the gardener. Gardeners may arrange for others to water their plots.
3. Garden plots should be cared for at least once a week. Neglected plots may be reassigned. Plots not planted by June 15th may be reassigned (unless conditions or crops require otherwise).
4. Garden plots must be mulched to conserve water and reduce weeds by June 30th (this does not apply to container or raised bed gardens)
5. Garden tools are available on site. Gardeners must clean & return tools to the shed after each use.
6. All Gardeners are required to perform maintenance tasks associated with the garden space. (See registration form for task list)
7. Children under 12 should be accompanied by an adult, under close supervision for the safety of all.
8. You must remain at the plot while watering. (**Do not leave the water running when you leave the area.**)
9. The use of non-organic herbicides (commercial weed killers, fungal killers etc.) and non-organic pesticides on garden plots is prohibited.
10. Gardeners may only harvest from their own plots.
11. Plots are assigned on a first come basis.
12. Gardeners are responsible for clearing their plot of all plant material. If you have planted perennials, and you do not intend to rent the plot next year, the plants must be removed from the plot prior to April 20th of the following year (aka the plants can winter over at the plot).
