Morning Sun Park

1.4 acre neighborhood park
Located in the Morning Sun Development, the park has a half-court basketball area, play structures, benches, and picnic tables.

North Meadow Park

2.2 acre neighborhood park
Located in the North Meadow neighborhood, the park features swings and a play structure with handicap transfer stations for age ranges 2 thru 12, a basketball half-court, baseball diamond, picnic tables, and portable toilet.

Twin Oaks Park

1 acre neighborhood park
This park features a play structure with slides, swings, and climbing rock and a picnic table are also provided.

Veterans Memorial Park

0.5 acre neighborhood park
The park features a play structure with slides, swings, handicap swing, hydration station, portable toilet, bike repair station and information kiosk

Allemansrätt Wilderness Park

120 acre wilderness park with trails, lakes, and camping
The park contains unique ecological features such as glacial eskers and ephemeral wetlands, a high quality oak forest, over 100 species of birds, diverse wildlife, several miles of trails, a historic house with murals and picnic areas and two first come first served hike in campsites are available.

Pump House Park

1.25 acre neighborhood park
Located in a residential neighborhood, the park features a baseball diamond, soccer practice board, picnic tables, portable toilet, play structure with handicap transfer stations slides and swings.

Swedish Immigrant Regional Trail

20 mile multi-use hard surface trail
The Swedish Immigrant Regional Trail provides a safe route for recreation and alternative transportation, while interpreting and celebrating the Swedish Immigrant History of Chisago County.

Chisago Lakes Middle School

Middle school campus with sports fields
The site contains soccer field, tennis courts and pickleball courts.

Lindström Beach Park

3 acre community park
The park features a swimming beach, boat dock, fishing pier, pavilion, picnic tables, grills, sand volleyball, play structure with handicap transfer station and portable toilets.

Linden Street Overlook

Scenic overlook onto South Lindström Lake
This beautiful overlook connects the City of Lindström's downtown to South Lindström Lake

Shoreview Circle Tot-Lot

Neighborhood playground area

Lion's Park

5.5 acre park next to City Hall hosting live music
The park features a pavilion, picnic tables, grills, playground, bandshell, island/peninsula landscape feature, restrooms and a "Lions Head" drinking fountain.

Pleasant Hill Park

0.64 acre neighborhood park
This neighborhood park is located on Pleasant Avenue and features a play structure with slides and swings.

Town & Country Park

4.5 acre neighborhood park
The park is designed as a "teen" park with a climbing wall, basketball half-court, skateboard area, and space-age play equipment.

Chisago Lakes High School

High school campus with sports fields
The site contains baseball and softball fields, soccer field and running track.

Chisago Lakes Golf Course

18-hole golf course

Ki-Chi-Saga County Park

98 acre park managed by Chisago County
The park features a softball complex, children's play structure, picnic shelter, volleyball courts, horseshoe pitches, nature hiking and winter ski trail and is adjacent to a state game refuge.

Kroon Lake Park

2.25 neighborhood park
Located in Lakeside Woodlands neighborhood, this park features a play structure with handicap transfer stations, basketball half-court, baseball field, portable toilet and picnic tables.

Olinda Trail Multi-Use Trail

1.75 mile multi-use hard surface trail
The Olinda Trail is 1.75 miles long and considered a linear park. The trail connects downtown Lindström with the High School, Community Center and our southern neighborhoods along Olinda Trail to 288th Street.
