Grease & Wipes Causing Sewer Backups

Please do not flush "flushable" wipes or other so-called "flushable" hygiene products down the toilet. Although these items are advertised as flushable, they are not. Dispose of these "flushable" items in the trash.

Even **small amounts** of grease and cooking oil accumulate in

pipes over time, and often ends up a giant ball of sludge in the sewer line. Please **do not dump any grease or cooking oil** down your drain or toilet. Pour into a sealed, 1-gallon or smaller container and **put in the garbage.**

Grease, cooking oil, and so-

called "flushable" products eventually clog pipes, and **have been the culprit in multiple sewer backups this year**. These repairs are costly. Clogs can also cause sewage to back up into your home or other homes in your neighborhood. <u>Please do</u> your part to prevent these issues. *Thank you!*

2023 has been a year of change at Lindström City Hall.

City Administrator Vacancy

In December of 2022, City Administrator John Olinger resigned. At a Special City Council meeting on 1/12/23, City Council appointed Lindström's Deputy Clerk/Office Manager, Melissa (Missy) Glenna, as the Interim City Administrator.

The City Council chose to hire a recruiting firm to handle the search for a permanent City Administrator. The search is now in the next phase, as the job opening closed on April 17th. The final pool of candidates will be interviewed sometime in May. The City anticipates having our new City Administrator in place in late June or early July, depending upon the

In January of 2023, Mayor Stenson and Council Member Burington resigned from the City Council. The vacant Council seats were filled by appointment, which is the typical course of action in such instances. If the City Council had chosen to conduct a Special Election this year rather than choosing the appointment process, the earliest the City could have conducted a Special Election would have been August of 2023 due to filing and posting requirements.

Council Member Judy Chartrand was appointed to the vacant Mayor seat, and EDA Member Greg Krueger and former Council Member David Waldoch were appointed to the vacant Council Member seats in March. Congratulations, Mayor Chartrand, Council Member Krueger, and Council Member Waldoch!
